Dual Screen with Trans Image and Compression

- CFV/GSV
- Femoral Vein Prox, Mid and Distal
- Popliteal Vein
- Peroneal Veins
- Posterior Tibial Veins

Sag Color Doppler and Pulse Wave Doppler

*for Pulse Wave Doppler show phasic flow and augmentation (if negative)

- CFV
- GSV
- Femoral Vein Prox with Profunda
- Femoral Vein Mid
- Femoral Vein Distal
- Popliteal Vein
- Peroneal Veins
- Posterior Tibial Veins

***Per Dr. Gray, any time you're looking at a fluid collection in the popliteal fossa, please label it as lateral or medial. If lateral it has the possibility of being a synovial carcinoma, if it is medial it is more likely to be a Baker's Cyst.
